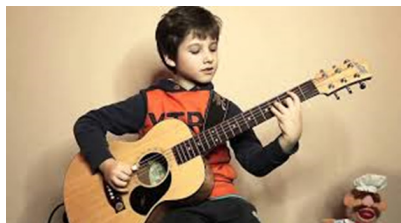
Reminders
