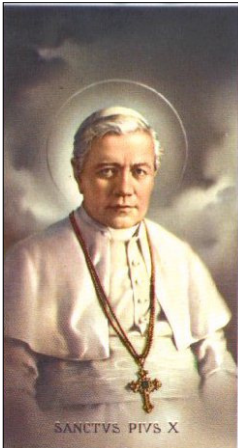

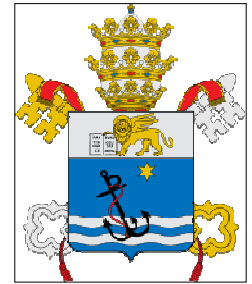


St Pius X Feast Day

We would appreciate payment by Monday morning, but if this is difficult please let us know at the office as to when you are able to make payment. Thank you.

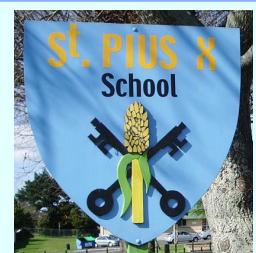
