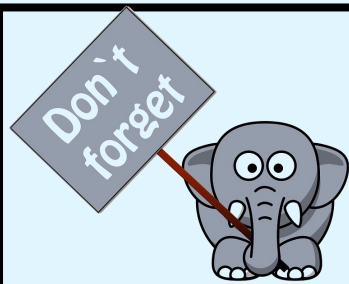
A small plate for the morning tea would also be appreciated.
