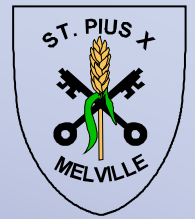

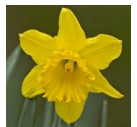
Principal's Message

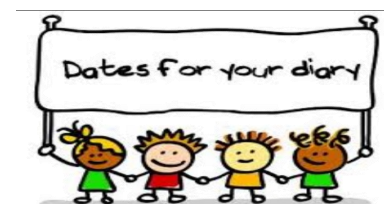

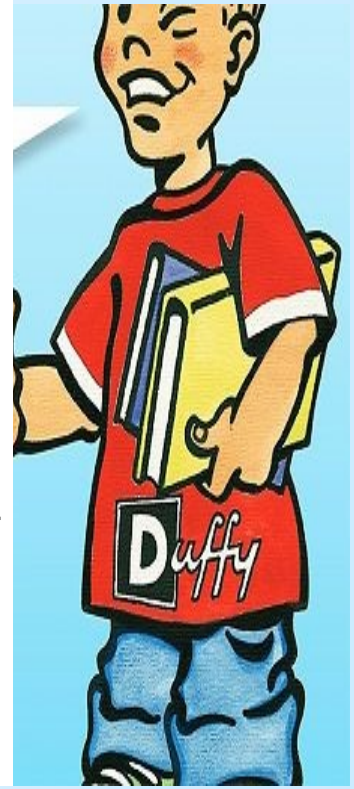
Duffy Fathers Day
