If your child is going to be absent from school, there are a number of ways to let us know:

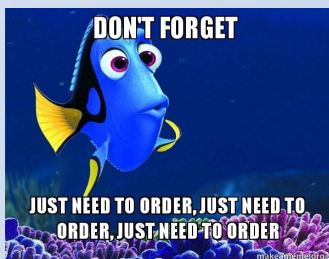
You can call our school on 07 8436554 and select the absence line to leave a message. Please speak CLEARLY and tells us your child's name and the reason for their absence.
